JOB PURPOSE: Nursery Worker will work under the overall guidance of the Ministry of Natural Resources and Commerce and under the direct supervision of the Chief of Agriculture. The incumbent will work in close consultation and coordination with the RMI Government in carrying out his/ her tasks and duties

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Responsible for selecting a site for gardening, lining out and spacing plants, making composts, preparing seedbeds, weeding and watering
2. Monitor plants from insects or disease and apply treatment
3. Carry out other duties as required

MAIN DUTIES AND OUTCOMES:

- 1.1. Establish, maintain and operate the nursery for the propagation of planting material of food crop trees/ root crops/ vegetables/ fruits
- 1.2. Establishment and maintenance of composting facility for the nursery
- 1.3. Update records for nursery operations
- 1.4. Supervise the preparation of soil potting mix for seedlings and provide technical advice to households
- 1.5. Prepare a brief monthly update on the progress of activities undertaken and share with the Secretary of NRC and Chief of Agriculture
- 1.6. Carry out other related duties as required by the Secretary of NRC


